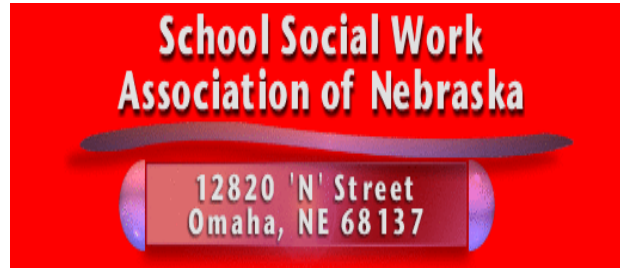

Principles of the Nebraska Legislative System

Senator Galen Hadley was elected to the Nebraska Legislature in 2008 to represent the 37th District. He received a B.A. and B.S. from the University of Nebraska – Lincoln, an M.B.A. from the University of Colorado, and a Ph.D. from the University of Nebraska – Lincoln. He is a former professor at the University of Nebraska at Kearney. Senator Hadley has previously held positions as the Kearney mayor, Good Samaritan Hospital Board, Kearney Area Chamber of Commerce, and the Buffalo County Economic Development Board.

Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) Structured Decision Making Model

Von Alavi has been working for DHHS for 8 years. He was a supervisor for 5 years and has been an administrator for 3 years. Von is also a trainer for the Structured Decision Making model.

Structured Decision Making is the model that DHHS has adopted to guide decision making on a case. This presentation will provide an overview of why that decision was made and what assessments are utilized in the decision making process.

Dr. Jean Anderson has been in the field of special education currently serving as the Special Education Coordinator at Educational Service Unit 10. Her experiences and education are in the area of working with kids with learning disabilities and behavioral challenges.
